The P&C, with school cooperation, have made a decision that Hervey Bay State High School is a uniform school to ensure that students are easily identified while at school and are safe on the way to and from school.

Everyday Uniform

The school's Uniform Shop provides a selection of styles for students to choose from.

Students are required to wear white or black socks and shoes must be fully black (no white soles or laces), fully enclosed.

Winter Uniform

Students may wear a monogrammed school jacket or jumper, long black pants or plain black track pants during cooler days.

Students may choose to wear tights, however, these MUST be worn under school shorts or skirts. Tights are not acceptable as a 'wear-alone' option.
