

PLAYERS AND PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

Hervey Bay State High School strongly supports and encourages parents/carers to attend school sporting competitions to support our players. We are very fortunate to have dedicated staff supervising this additional activity, enabling your student to participate in extra-curricular activities and competitions. The following expectations will be placed on players and parents, when attending such events:

- Supervising staff and coaches must be treated with the upmost respect.
- Unsportsmanlike language, harassment or aggressive behaviour towards school officials and coaches will not be tolerated.
- We encourage all players, parents and spectators to demonstrate respectful behaviour and respect all decisions made by school officials and referees.
- Never ridicule or scorn a player, coach or coaching staff for making a mistake – respect their efforts.
- Participation in positive cheering that encourages the players in the team you are supporting.
- All parents/carers need to use the appropriate channels of communication and contact the school office if they would like to communicate or address a concern.

If a player and/or parent does not adhere to the above expectations and doesn't respond to assistance provided, they will be issued with a breach notice and may be prohibited from attending future school sporting events.
