## **Core Subjects**

Please be aware that in 2024, National Curriculum requirements state that all students must study English, Mathematics and Science. For this reason, students will be limited to three elective subjects.

- Number five (5) preferences for elective subjects. Every effort will be made to accommodate student's highest choices. Popularity of subjects will dictate whether there will be multiple classes of the same subject.
- Music: Students who have not participated in the Music program in Year 8 and/or 9 will need to meet with the music staff to audition/perform before acceptance into the class will occur
- Due to the nature of the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) curriculum, the STEM elective subject will be available to those students who have achieved a 'B' rating or better for their Mathematics and Science results in year 9.
- Students' academic performance in subjects during Year 9, may be used to determine whether a student will be placed in elective subjects (based on class numbers).
